- Set up by publishers to enable reliable reference linking.
- Bringing together publishers and their data for the benefit of the whole community.
- 16-member international board of directors from membership


What We Do

- Network for Scholarly Community
- Run services publishers cannot do individually
- Facilitator for industry technical innovation
- Extended to include other data and services that address the status and relationships of and between scholarly works of all kinds.
- Engage many types of organizations: Publishers and "non-publisher" publishers; Commercial and nonprofits; OA & Subscription; Funders; Researchers; Libraries


CrossRef DOIs uniquely identify content



Crossref DOIs are not just for journals



We generate well over a billion annual 'clicks' to publishers' sites



So far in 2015 Crossref has serviced well over 5 billion requests for metadata

So how does this work?

Publishers give Crossref metadata

- Basic citation metadata:
 - author(s)
 - journal title
 - article title
 - volume
 - Issue
 - page numbers
 - publication date
 - book title
 - chapter title

- Optional metadata, e.g.
 - references
 - funder information
 - ORCIDs
 - CrossMark publication record metadata
 - Abstracts
 - License data

The DOI is the key for a metadata record

If you don't have the key you can't get the metadata

Why a DOI?

It's actionable, a person can click on a DOI link

Why Crossref?

Crossref aggregates a lot of metadata

Crossref provides service built on this metadata


- Reference linking
- Cited-By linking
- Funding data (what articles result from a given award/grant)
- Inter and Intra work relationships (ex: translations)
- Important information for the reader (corrections, retractions · · · etc)
- License terms for Text & Data Mining
- 2016: Doi Event Tracking






