




- Over 12,000 member organizations





You can still choose to hide/show whatever works you choose, and, of course



- When publishers deposit an author's ORCID with the article metadata, Crossref will request long-term permission from that author to post works to their ORCID record.
- Once permission is granted, Crossref will automatically post these works to the authors record and any future publications from any Crossref member.
- Any article deposited with an author's ORCID in the past will also get automatically pushed to the record after permission has been granted.




## In the author's ORCID record
